Rules & Safety

- Teams can comprise up to 15 members. It is recommended that a team have at least 10 members
 - To be eligible for team awards, the team can consist of no greater than fifteen (15) participants. Teams can be larger than fifteen (15), however will not be eligible for team awards.
 - To be eligible for team awards, one player must be on the court throughout the 24 hour event.
 - Squash & Racquetball may be played – singles or doubles – players on court to choose which discipline, if players are undecided then a toss of a racquet between the two players will decide.
 - Games are to be played using PAR (point of rally) scoring.
 - World Squash Federation Rules of Squash apply.
 - The team captain (or appointed representative) is responsible for rostering players on court in 13 minute blocks.
 - The order, duration and number of times a team member plays is at the discretion of the team.
 - Each team must keep track of the points accumulated using the score sheet provided.
 - Two teams per court and teams are rotated every few hours to enable all teams to play each other.
 - Participants under 18 years are to be supervised by parent or legal guardian at all times.
 - Guardians of participants under 18 years of age provide written consent to participant when registering online or offline.
 - Maximum of four players are permitted on court at any one time.
 - Protective eyewear that complies with Squash Australia regulations is compulsory for all players 19 years and younger and must be worn at all times when on court.
 - Good sportsman-like conduct will be demanded of all competitors. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will be grounds for instant disqualification.
 - The 24 Hour Mega Squash & Racquetball is strictly a smoke, drug and alcohol free event.
- N.B.** It is the responsibility of all participants to ensure their health and safety at the event.

Awards

Overall Winning Team Award

The most prestigious of all awards, the winning team will receive 1 point for every \$10 raised and 1 point for every 10 points won - every team has a chance to win!

Highest Individual Fundraiser

Awarded to the individual who has raised the most funds.

Youth Award

Awarded to a young individual for their fundraising effort and active participation throughout the event.
